## Findings of Graduates Exit Survey of Academic Year 2023/2024

To assess the student learning outcomes, an exit survey is used to collect feedback. Particularly, we asked students to indicate if they can achieve the learning outcomes. 22 out of the 78 graduated students submitted the exit survey and the response rate is 28%. Generally speaking, more than half of the students agreed that they can achieve the learning outcomes. Reviewing the findings, we will continue to provide information concerning applications and professional career options for students.
